2019 WVSOM NADA Acudetox Certification Training INFORMATIONAL SHEET

What is it?

The NADA Acudetox certification training will be a 3-day, intensive course in acudetox technique delivered by national NADA Registered Trainers. Providers will be trained to use a simple, safe and standardized ear acupuncture protocol to treat addictions, behavioral health, trauma and for use in disaster relief. Upon successful completion of the hands-on course and required homework, the provider will be eligible to receive NADA Certification as an Acupuncture Detox Specialist (ADS).

Who is eligible to attend?

Must currently reside in West Virginia, be at least 18 years of age and be eligible for Acudetox Specialist (ADS) Certification in the state of West Virginia. Those eligible for ADS certification in WV include:

- Physicians, dentists, medical students
- Nurse practitioners, RNs, LPNs
- Physician Assistants
- Physical therapists/Occupational therapists
- Licensed Social Workers
- Licensed Professional Counselors/Psychologist
- Emergency Medical Services provider
- Corrections medical providers

When and where are the training sessions?

All training sessions are held at the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine in the Osteopathic/Clinical Skills (OCS) classroom and lab. Directions on registration site.

- Session 1: August 2, 3 and 4: FILLED
- Session 2: August 16, 17, 18
- Session 3: September 27, 28, 29

You will only need to attend one weekend session and complete assigned homework in order to be able to apply for/receive NADA certification as an Acudetox Specialist.

Will there be a cost?

The \$425.00 cost (discounted from \$500.00) of the training will be covered by the State Opioid Response grant for the first 30 participants who sign up for each session (90 total). Additional fees not covered to become a WV Acudetox Specialist include:

- Application cost for NADA ADS Certification once all requirements are completed (\$70/\$40 Senior/Student)
- Application cost for WV ADS Certification (anticipated \$60.00 for two years)
